

We serve a diverse population across all programs and are on-site at 16 HISD and 4 Aldine ISD campuses as well as multi-community sites throughout Houston.





Literacy Crisis in Houston

- 41% of young children in the Houston area are not ready for kindergarten.
- 73% of third graders in Houston do not read at grade level.
- Low-income children will hear 30 million fewer words over the first four years of their life compared to their more affluent peers.
- 85% of children who interface with the juvenile justice system are functionally literate.

The Literacy Lab is a new program initiative of Literacy Now.



The Literacy Lab Program Overview

- The Literacy Lab is designed for people who have a passion to work with children and education, but do not have any formal training or degree in early childhood education or related fields.
- Participants must have a bachelor's degree from an accredited university.
- The program runs from 1/30/2023 through 4/27/2023*.
- Throughout this program, participants will be trained in small group instruction, how to work with struggling readers, how to work in a school environment, and much more.
- After successful completion of this program, participants will be offered a part-time position with Literacy Now as a Reading Interventionist.

LITERACY NOW PROGRAMS



Reading Intervention is an individualized, small group instruction for Kindergarten through 2nd-grade students reading significantly below grade level.



The Reading Express is a mobile classroom that is designed to develop phonological and print awareness, oral language, fine motor and other early literacy skills through the exploration of books, nursery rhymes, songs, art and play for children with their parent/caregiver.



Lunch Bunch has trained volunteer mentors to meet with small groups of single-gender students to promote positive decision-making and healthy relationships.

Parent engagement and partnerships are important for us to educate and empower parents with additional skills and materials to expand their children's learning at home.






