If so, take advantage of this great opportunity to impact the students Literacy Now serves.

Group Storytime is a great team building opportunity that provides 48 or 64 (depending upon the campus) of our Reading Intervention program students (K-2nd grade) with a fun way to improve their literacy skills.

Depending upon the number of children served, 12 – 16 volunteers will each be assigned to a group of 4 students with whom they will share a snack, chat, read the selected book, and complete a craft activity in theme with the book. Each child will receive a copy of the book read to take home.

Group Storytimes are quick, fun, and impactful! The total time at a school campus is about 90 minutes, 45 minutes with the children and 45 minutes for set-up/clean-up. Time with the children typically begins between 1:00pm and 1:30pm.
