

 meeting costs.








A springtime event orchestrated by the Guild to introduce guests to the work of Literacy Now, recruit Guild members, and raise funds to support all programs.





Group Storytime: Gather up a group of 12 – 16 friends or colleagues to host a group of our Reading Intervention students to read a book, share a snack, and complete a fun book-related activity (Nov – April) at a cost of \$350 – \$500/group.
